## **Funding Update**

From September 2025, all children currently receiving 15 hours of working parent funding will become eligible for 30 hours of funded childcare.

To discuss or update your child's schedule in line with the increased hours, please contact Madihah on gateway@sherwoodgreennursery.co.uk.

If you believe you may be eligible for this funding but are not yet receiving it, please visit <a href="www.childcarechoices.gov.uk">www.childcarechoices.gov.uk</a> and complete the form to check your eligibility.

Important: If you are applying for a new code, this must be obtained and sent to us before 31st August 2025 in order for your child to access the funding from September 2025.

The children will be taking part in lots of fun and creative activities, including graduation-themed artwork and role play to help them explore and understand this exciting transition.






## Happy Birthday

If your child brings gloves to nursery, we strongly advise for these to be attached and threaded through their coat to avoid any gloves going missing.

#### **High Temperatures and Fevers**

Please can we kindly remind parents that children cannot attend nursery if they have a high temperature (37.6°C). If a child develops a temperature whilst at nursery, parents will be called to collect them, as supported by our policies and procedures.

#### No Mobile Phones

Mobile phones are not to be used whilst on nursery site, including taking photographs and having conversations. This is part of our Safeguarding policy. Please use this valuable time to converse with your child or get to know other parents at Sherwood Green.. Our staff will politely remind you of this policy..
