From September 2025, all children currently receiving 15 hours of working parent funding will become eligible for 30 hours of funded childcare.

Important: If you are applying for a new code, this must be obtained and sent to us before **31st August 2025** in order for your child to access the funding from September 2025.





NATIONAL PLAY DAY

06.08.2025

National Play Day is a celebration dedicated to promoting the importance of play in the lives of children and families. On August 7, 2024, we will together celebrate the critical role that play has in the physical, emotional, and social development of children. Activities at Sherwood Green Nursery: To mark this day, we have planned a variety of fun and engaging activities for our children, including:

- Arts and Crafts: Creative stations where children can explore their artistic talents and create their own masterpieces.

Reading helps children grow their imagination, language skills, and love for learning. Our nursery library is full of wonderful books, and we'd love for you and your child to join in. Here's how it works:




- 1. Choose a Book: Let your child pick a book that interests them. We have a variety of picture books and storybooks for all ages.
