### HARVEST FESTIVAL

For our youngest children, we will offer sensory play with natural items like leaves, pinecones, and soft autumn textures, encouraging them to explore the colours and feel of the season. They will also enjoy simple harvest-themed stories, focusing on sounds and rhythms.

For toddlers and pre-schoolers, we will read harvest stories about farming, food, and thankfulness, followed by autumn crafts using leaves and nature-inspired materials. Children will contribute to a "thankful tree," sharing things they are grateful for. As part of our celebrations, they will take a short autumn walk around the nursery, collecting leaves to use in crafts and sensory play.

As we celebrate Grandparents Day at nursery, children will take part in special activities to show their love and appreciation. They will create lovely keepsakes and thoughtful gifts, using a variety of materials and crafts to make something unique for their grandparents.

## **BLOSSOM APP - STAY CONNECTED!**



### **High Temperatures and Fevers**

Please can we kindly remind parents that children cannot attend nursery if they have a high temperature (37.6°C). If a child develops a temperature whilst at nursery, parents will be called to collect them, as supported by our policies and procedures.

Mobile phones are not to be used whilst on nursery site, including taking photographs and having conversations. This is part of our Safeguarding policy. Please use this valuable time to converse with your child or get to know other parents at Sherwood Green.. Our staff will politely remind you of this policy..
