Reading helps children grow their imagination, language skills, and love for learning. Our nursery library is full of wonderful books, and we'd love for you and your child to join in. Here's how it works:



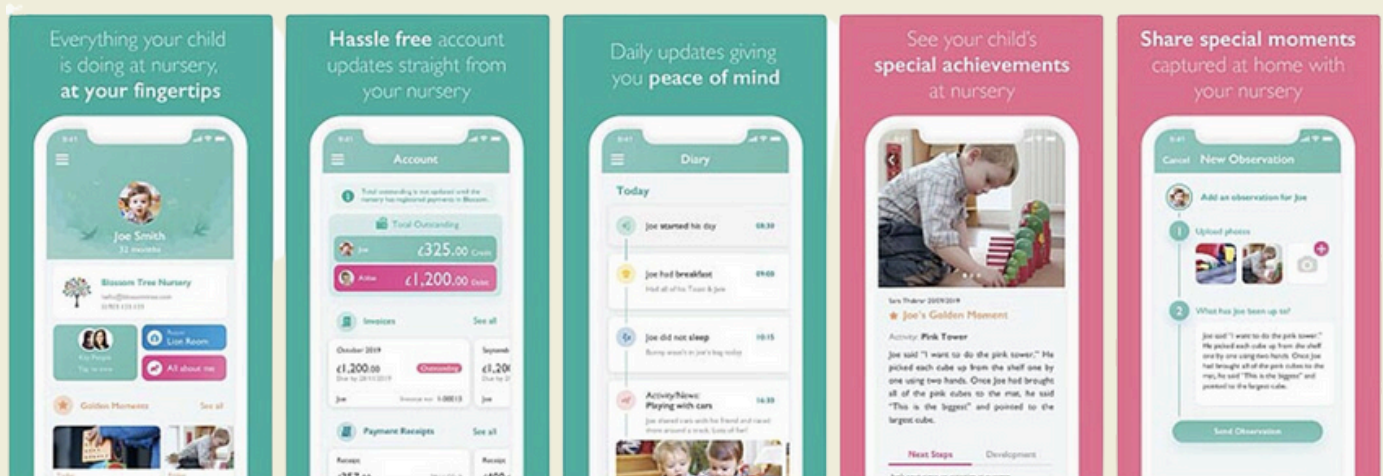
1. **Choose a Book:** Let your child pick a book that interests them. We have a variety of picture books and storybooks for all ages.

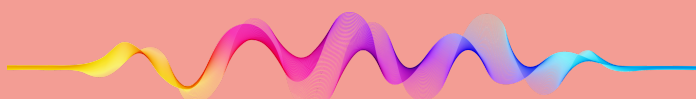
PRESCHOOL & TODDLER

Absence
