Reading helps children grow their imagination, language skills, and love for learning. Our nursery library is full of wonderful books, and we'd love for you and your child to join in. Here's how it works:




- 1. **Choose a Book:** Let your child pick a book that interests them. We have a variety of picture books and storybooks for all ages.


ROALD DHAL STORY DAY














AUTUMN

IAN'S FARM 25.09.25


WE ARE EXCITED TO WELCOME "IAN'S FARM" ON THURSDAY 25TH SEPTEMBER 9AM12PM

Please can we kindly remind parents that children cannot attend nursery if they have a high temperature (37.6°C). If a child develops a temperature whilst at nursery, parents will be called to collect them, as supported by our policies and procedures.
