PRESCHOOL ROOM: WINTER ANIMALS

THIS WEEK, THE CHILDREN ARE LEARNING ABOUT WINTER ANIMALS. THEY ARE EXPLORING ANIMALS THAT LIVE IN COLD PLACES AND HOW ANIMALS STAY WARM IN WINTER. THE CHILDREN ARE USING TUFF TRAYS TO PLAY, INVESTIGATE, AND TALK ABOUT WINTER ANIMALS THROUGH HANDS-ON ACTIVITIES.

THEY ARE EXPLORING SNOW, ICE, ANIMAL HOMES, FOOTPRINTS, AND ANIMALS THAT SLEEP IN WINTER. THE CHILDREN ARE DEVELOPING LANGUAGE, CURIOSITY, AND UNDERSTANDING THROUGH PLAY AND INVESTIGATION.

TODDLER ROOM- THIS WEEK, THE TODDLERS ARE EXPLORING ROLE PLAY THROUGH EVERYDAY EXPERIENCES. THE ROLE PLAY AREA IS SET UP WITH FAMILIAR ITEMS SO CHILDREN CAN COPY WHAT THEY SEE AT HOME AND IN THEIR WORLD.

THE CHILDREN ARE PRETENDING TO COOK, CARE FOR BABIES, AND ACT OUT DAILY ROUTINES. THEY ARE USING SIMPLE WORDS, ACTIONS, AND GESTURES WHILE PLAYING TOGETHER. THROUGH ROLE PLAY, THE TODDLERS ARE BUILDING CONFIDENCE, DEVELOPING COMMUNICATION SKILLS, AND LEARNING TO SHARE AND TAKE TURNS.



BABY ROOM – Exploring Textures

Exploring Textures is planned based on babies' natural curiosity about the world around them. Children engage in hands-on activities with soft, rough, bumpy, and squishy materials, discovering different sensations while developing sensory awareness and early cognitive skills. They enjoy touching and feeling a variety of textures, supporting fine motor development, curiosity, and early language as they learn words to describe what they feel.



NATIONAL HANDWRITING DAY

23.01.2026

Get ready to grab those crayons and practice those first letters on January 23, 2026, as we celebrate National Handwriting Day with fun and engaging writing activities at nursery! Handwriting isn't just about forming letters—it helps develop fine motor skills, hand-eye coordination, and early literacy, while giving children a sense of pride as they see their own creations come to life.

- **Preschool Room:** Children will practice forming letters and their names using crayons, pencils, and tracing sheets. They'll also explore fun writing games and activities to build fine motor skills and early literacy in an engaging way.
- **Toddler Room:** Toddlers will enjoy mark-making with crayons, paint, and finger-paints, experimenting with shapes, lines, and early letters. These activities encourage creativity, hand-eye coordination, and confidence in making their first strokes.
- **Baby Room:** Babies will explore sensory writing experiences using safe, textured materials like finger paints, sand trays, and soft crayons. These hands-on activities support sensory development, early hand control, and curiosity in a fun and playful way.



NATIONAL PUZZLE DAY

29.01.2026

Get ready to exercise those little brains and have a blast on January 29, 2026, as we celebrate National Puzzle Day with a day filled with exciting jigsaw activities! Puzzles are not just fun, they also offer a plethora of cognitive benefits for your child's development.





PLANTING DAY

15.01.2026

The children will be enjoying planting activities as part of their outdoor play! They will listen to the story Jasper's Beanstalk to learn about how seeds grow, understand the basic steps of planting, and then get hands-on experience planting their own beans. Children will have the exciting opportunity to care for their plants and watch them grow over time, developing an understanding of nature, patience, and responsibility while having lots of fun in the garden.

Planting activities in early years provide children with hands-on learning about nature, growth, and the life cycle of plants. They develop fine motor skills through digging and watering, explore their senses with soil and seeds, and build patience as they watch plants grow. Caring for plants also encourages responsibility, curiosity, early science skills, and language development, while fostering creativity and a connection to the natural world.

Reading helps children grow their imagination, language skills, and love for learning. Our nursery library is full of wonderful books, and we'd love for you and your child to join in. Here's how it works:



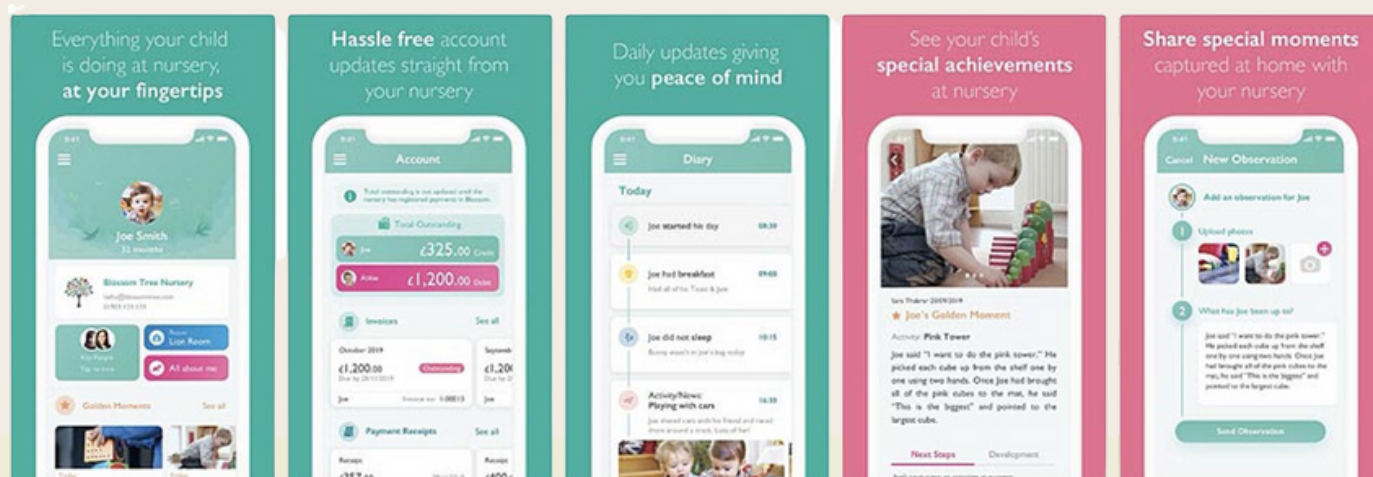
- 1. Choose a Book:** Let your child pick a book that interests them. We have a variety of picture books and storybooks for all ages.

If you have any problems downloading or accessing the app, please let us know, and we'll be happy to help you.



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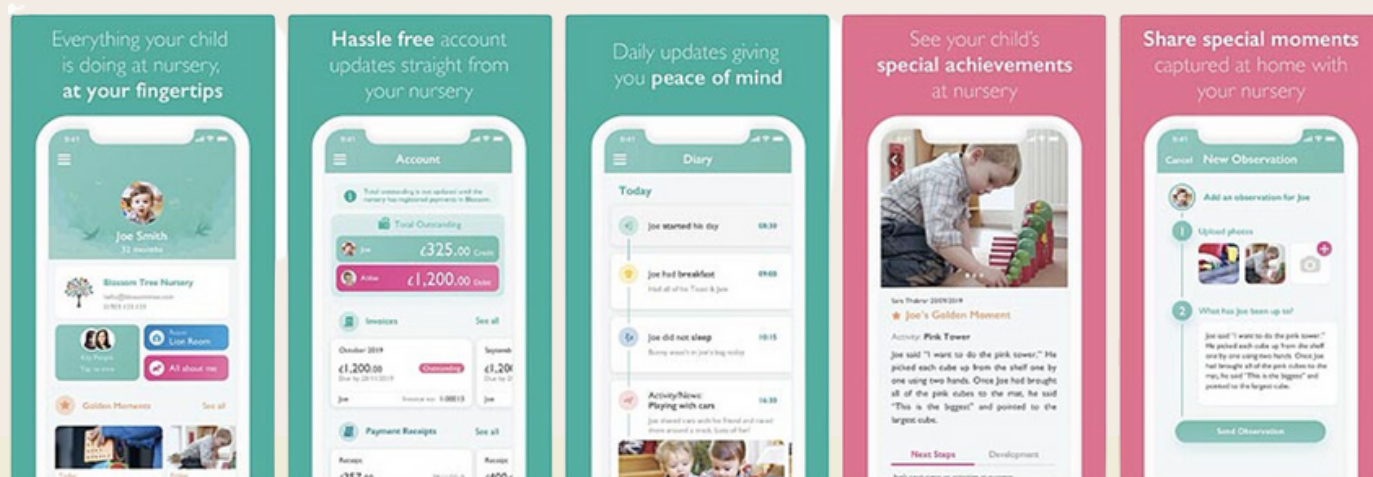
